Post op graft – Wound care**

Practice good hand hygiene - always wash your hands with antibacterial soap before changing the dressing or touching your wound to apply medication.

- Graft is now in its new home, but very new to its new home. Pt needs to continue to be very gentle with the graft for another 2 weeks to ensure the graft lives. Still no rigorous exercise or heavy lifting for another 2 weeks.

- Start very gentle wound care:
 - We now want soapy water to run over the graft site once daily. Avoid letting the shower water to directly hit the graft site.
 - Gently apply Vaseline, Aquaphor, or Polysporin twice daily for 2 weeks then can discontinue
