Post op graft – Wound care**

Practice good hand hygiene - always wash your hands with antibacterial soap before changing the dressing or touching your wound to apply medication.

- The graft is now living in its new home, but it is very delicate. You need to continue to be very gentle with the graft for another 2 weeks to ensure the graft lives. Still no rigorous exercise or heavy lifting for another 2 weeks.
- Start very gentle wound care:
 - We now want soapy water to run over the graft site once daily. Avoid letting the shower water directly hit the graft site.
 - Gently apply Vaseline, Aquaphor, or Polysporin twice daily for 2 weeks then can discontinue
 - The graft should continue to look better and better each day
